

Application for The Timothy Long Classics Scholarship

Scholarship Description

1. One scholarship of no less than \$250.00 (actual amount determined by fundraising in the year scholarship is given) will be awarded to the graduating North Central Latin student who best exemplifies the qualities promoted by the Junior Classical League and best fulfills the criteria.
2. The money will be sent to the recipient upon notification by the winner through official university or college transcript that the winner has completed one semester- or quarter-long course in Latin, Greek, Classical civilization, ancient Greek or Roman history, ancient Greek or Roman art, or ancient Greek or Roman archaeology. An etymology course will be considered insufficient to meet the requirements of the scholarship.
3. The committee to evaluate the applications will be comprised of the current North Central Latin teacher and two other members of the North Central faculty.
4. The scholarship will be available to all North Central Latin students in their senior year who plan to continue their education in an institution of higher learning that offers one of the courses listed in #2 above.
5. The scholarship is not renewable.
6. The applicant must be enrolled in Latin at the time of application and must be a member of the North Central chapter of the Indiana Junior Classical League.
7. Applicants will be judged on the following criteria (listed in order of importance for judging the applications):
 - a. Interest in Classics
 - b. Leadership/service, especially in Latin and JCL
 - c. Character
 - d. Scholarship
8. Funds for the scholarship will be obtained from the following sources:
 - a. Individual donations
 - b. Fundraising through the North Central Junior Classical League
